

Setting Up a Webmail Account on iPhone or Android

How to Add Webmail to iPhone

Step 1

Press the "Settings" button on your iPhone.

Step 2

Press the "Mail, Contacts, Calendars" button in the "Settings" menu.

Step 3

Press the "Add Account..." option in the "Mail, Contacts, Calendars" menu.

Step 4

When a list of webmail service providers appears, which includes Gmail, Yahoo, AOL, Microsoft Exchange, MobileMe, and Other, select the webmail service provider of your choice. If your particular webmail service provider is not included in the list, just select "Other."

Step 5

If you have selected "Other" in the previous step, press "Add Mail Account." Skip this step if you have not chosen the "Other" option.

Step 6

Press "Name" and type in your name, then press "return."

Step 7

Fill out the email address with your webmail service account and then press "return." For instance, you can use the following format: me@yahoo.com or name@webmail.com.

Step 8

Fill out your password for your webmail service account and then press "Return."

Step 9

Filling out your service description is optional. If you would not want to, just press "Next."

Step 10

Fill out the ingoing and outgoing mail with pop3 information. In a webmail account, the pop3 information would appear like this: mail.yahoo.com or mail.myweburl.com.

Step 11

Fill out your webmail service account with username and password and then press "Save" on the top-right corner. Your iPhone will then verify your account and sync with your webmail service.

How to Add Webmail to Android

Step 1

Go to the Menu and add a new account. Select the "setup new account" button. If you cannot find the "add a new account" option, you can find it in the settings under accounts.

Step 2

Fill out your incoming service settings with your full email address, password, POP Server, Security Type, and Server Port. Make sure to type in your full email address. For your POP Server, type in mail.pysfl.com as your incoming server. Select None for your Security Type for a default. For the Server Port, select 110 which is also a default. After completing the required information, click "Next."

Step 3

Fill out your outgoing service settings with SMTP Server details. For your outgoing SMTP server, you can use mail.pysfl.com. Select None (default) for Security Type while for the Server Port, use the port 366 as the SMTP port 25 is blocked by most of the ISP's to avoid spam. Then, press "Next."

Step 4

Name the account according to your preference so that you can identify your account yourself. You may identify it as "work email" or just use the actual email address. A list of option will also appear if it is your default email account. Click "Finish" to accomplish the setup.
